Registration:

Registration will occur from 2:45 PM – 5:45 PM on Friday, November 18th at the Reitz Union in room 2360. For the location of the Reitz Union, you can use either the University of Florida campus map, or google maps. All delegates must have registered and paid in full by the end of the allocated registration period. CONFERENCE CODE OF CONDUCT

There will be zero tolerance regarding harassment of any form, including but not limited to: discrimination on basis of race, socioeconomic status, sex, religion, ethnicity, gender identity, sexual orientation, or mental and physical abilities. Please report any incidents of harassment to the Secretariat, they shall be thoroughly investigated, and the Secretariat reserves the right to act as deemed necessary.
- 2. All conference participants are expected to abide in accordance with local and federal legality. This includes (but is not limited to) laws regarding purchase and possession of alcohol, alongside laws regarding the trafficking and possession of illicit substances. Delegates found engaging in illicit activities may be expelled from the Conference and/or the University of Florida campus, in some instances they may be held criminally liable.
- 3. The Secretariat reserves the right to discipline and expel from the Conference for inappropriate behavior or violation of regulations. This is included but not limited to: the usage of foul language, suggestive remarks, and obscene body language. SunMUN staff reserves the right to read all notes passed during committee sessions.
- 4. Neither smoking nor consumption of alcohol is permitted on the University of Florida campus t any time.
- 5. In the event of vandalism or property damage occurring on the University of Florida campus or in delegates respective lodgings, neither SunMUN nor any of its agents will accept responsibility. As such, individuals will be held responsible and not the conference. Please note that neither SunMUN nor UFMUN will be held responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to personal items.
